1. October Minutes–approved
2. Treasurer’s Report – Kristi Macarro
 - a. \$989.44– in bank
 - b. Payment for GoDaddy Domain - \$43.85 for 2 years – paid in full
3. Clinton Pedestrian Safety Issues – Doug Hofius
 - a. Sidewalk on south side of 525 going down to the Ferry Dock from the Park and Ride is not safe – particularly near Ferry Dock Rd and 525.
 - b. WSDOT is responsible for this sidewalk. No money is in the current legislative budget for repairs.
 - c. Attempts have been made and will continue to be made to contact elected officials and WSDOT to secure financing for repairs and maintenance now rather than 2-4 years from now. Need to eliminate drainage problem, repair sidewalk and plan for maintenance.
 - d. Determine who currently has the maintenance contract, and has it lapsed
 - e. Contact Lei Lu at WSDOT
4. Clinton Corridor Plan – Beckye Frey
 - a. Council wants to increase visibility of Clinton in the Comprehensive Plan Update by focusing on the positive aspects of Clinton
 - b. Gateway Study should provide greater clarity in defining the scope of the Clinton Corridor Plan
 - c. It is recommended that the council examine zoning boundaries as they relate to a RAID vs NMUGA by reviewing:
 1. smartgrowth.com which provides info on differing growth levels;
 2. potential zoning adjustments

6. Ferry Dock Rd Project – Doug Hofius
 - a. Need to provide the public with more information about the project
