3. Clinton Pedestrian Safety Issues – Doug Hofius, Jack Lynch, Curt Gordon
 - A. Sidewalk safety issues from the Park and Ride on SR525 to the Ferry:
 1. Two reported injuries in January
 2. Problems include:
 - a. Broken concrete
 - b. Poor drainage
 - c. Plant growth on sidewalk
 - B. The state is responsible for maintenance of the Park and Ride, the sidewalk, and SR525 but currently no funding available
 - C. Funding Options to Explore
 1. Send letter to Commissioner Price Johnson outlining issues to be presented at next IRTPPO meeting
 2. Contact our local and state representatives
 3. Check with Rick Larson on Multimodal funds
 4. Ferry Dock Rd upgrade
4. Clinton Corridor Plan – Beckye Frey
 - A. Currently examining Gateway plans
 1. Determining scope, policies and funding
 2. Reviewing Camano, Deception Pass and Clinton gateways
 - B. Reviewing zoning and boundaries
5. Ferry Dock Rd Project – Doug Hofius and Jack Lynch
 - A. At 60% design on Ferry Dock Road should finish in March
 - B. Work should begin summer 2018

 - Discussed Crosswalk example at Wilson Rd – cost \$750,000 that includes beacons, center refuge island, lights and curb bump-out
