#### a. Ken's Corner Trail

1. Funding approved for design phase of multimodal connection between Clinton Ferry Dock and Ken's Korner
2. Design team being determined and design work likely to begin in 2020

#### b. Regional Mobility Grant

1. State funding for sidewalk from Clinton Ferry to the Clinton Park and Ride
2. ADA compliant and crosswalks on cross streets

#### c. Pedestrian/Bike Grant

1. New ITPO Bill Oakes; Susan Driver Transportation Planner
2. No funding at this time; Our application didn't rank high enough
3. Need to reapply for funding for crosswalk across 525

#### a. Port of South Whidbey – Curt Gordon

Continuing to work on parking in Mukilteo

- b. Ferries – Dave Hoogerwerf
  - 1. Kitsap will be replacing the Tokitae (in for service) beginning tomorrow
  - 2. Ferry Fares increase October 1<sup>st</sup> - 2 ½% for all vehicles and 2% for passengers; same raise will occur May 1<sup>st</sup>
  - 3. Ferry Advisory Meeting on October 17th 6-8pm at the Clinton Community Hall; Community invited
- b. Ferry Dock Road progress – Doug Hofius
  - 1. Has been asphalted and is near completion
  - 2. Formal ribbon cutting ceremony probably in late October
- c. Chamber of Commerce – Stephanie Cook
  - Reviewed picnic funding and overall success of picnic
- d. Clinton Progressive Association – Catherine Billera
  - 1. Gas line was installed for new stove
  - 2. New stove and vent-a-hood to be installed
  - 3. Looking for an electrician
  - 4. New toilets and floors in the bathrooms
- e. Clinton Library – Carol Flax
  - 1. Looking for new board members
  - 2. Wells Fargo Bldg sale closed by investor; Sno-Isle can now evaluate the situation
- f. Parks Department – Dennis Hunter
