3. Treasurer's Report – Account and Budget Status    Don Simmons  
Written report submitted.. Net income for the year 2026 to date: **-186.78**. Bank balance (as of 3/30/26): \$2555.37. We have received 75% of our budgeted income to date. Our expenses to date are 65% of the budgeted amount.
4. Monthly Program: Walt, from South Whidbey Prepares, spoke about the work of the organization to empower individuals and communities to prepare to survive on their own in case of a natural disaster. They have monthly meetings and classes:
