3. Monthly Program: State Representative Dave Paul (District 10) reported on the most recent legislative session. It was a tight budget year. Representative Paul's main focus was on higher education funding and reports there were no substantial cuts to higher ed allocations. He also focused on making pathways to living wage jobs that do not require a college degree. He continues to focus on bringing communities together to work on common issues. And he continues to focus on ferries and funding new ones.

Written report submitted. Net income for the year 2026 to date: **-186.74**. Bank balance (as of 4/27/26): \$2555.41. We have received 75% of our budgeted income to date. Our expenses to date are 65% of the budgeted amount.
